

INSTRUCTIONS FOR SEPARATION OF WASTE:

| CONTAINER FOR PLASTIC | |

| YES | NO |
| - plastic bottles (juice, milk, yogurt, water - cleansed from the contents) | - packaging of motor oils, paints, varnishes and pesticides |
| - plastic packaging (plastic dishes), disposable dishes, plastic accessories | - cans of paints, varnishes, diluents and other easily flammable explosives |
| - toys that do not contain other materials | |
| - various bottles and boxes of cleaning agents and personal hygiene goods | - lighters |
| - Tetra Pak | |
| - foil | - pressure cans |
| - metal and aluminum packaging waste of food products (cans) | - styrofoam, sponges |

| CONTAINER FOR GLASS | |
|---|--|
| YES | NO |
| - glass bottles, jars, pots (area free of contents and without caps and lids) | - mirrors, window glass, crystal, bulbs, medical and laboratory glass, fluorescent tubes, automotive and armored glass, porcelain and ceramic dishes |
| - broken glasses | |

| CONTAINER FOR PAPER | |
|--|---|
| YES | NO |
| - paper and cardboard packaging | - plasticized paper and metallized paper, nylon bags, diapers, paper towels, vacuum cleaners bags |
| - letters, envelopes, office paper | - books and notebooks with plastic and leather covers |
| - newspapers, catalogs, journals, prospectuses, books without metal and leather bindings, paper bags | - wax paper, photos and photo paper, contaminated paper and cardboard |
| - Cardboard boxes of eggs | - Tetrapak packaging, plastic and multilayer packaging |
